## **APM Terminals Rotterdam Adds Two New Cranes**

**– New cranes target volume growth and productivity goals**

Rotterdam, The Netherlands – APM Terminals Rotterdam has taken delivery of two new ZPMC container cranes to better serve customers.

The two new cranes will complement the current 11 super post panamax cranes in operation capable of handling the world's largest container vessels.

APM Terminals Rotterdam is one of the busiest terminals in the global portfolio serving more than 15 mother vessels, 15 feeder vessels and 100 barge calls average per week. The terminal also handles more than 5000 container trucks a week and 3300 containers a week moved by rail to inland European locations.
