## **APM Terminals Signs New RTG Agreement**

**APM Terminals and ZPMC have finalized an agreement framework for the supply of rubber tired gantry cranes for the expanding APM Terminals Global Terminal Network**

**Shanghai, China** – APM Terminals and Chinese-based Shanghai Zhenhua Port Machinery (ZPMC) have concluded a Main Purchase Agreement for the future delivery of rubber-tired gantry cranes for use at APM Terminals’ growing roster of container handling facilities around the world. The signing ceremony was held on April 16<sup>th</sup> at the ZPMC offices in Shanghai. The MPA establishes a framework for the delivery schedule of RTGs in fulfillment of current and anticipated orders. APM Terminals has concluded similar agreements with Doosan Heavy Industries & Construction Co. Ltd., of South Korea, Noell Crane System GmbH, of Germany, and Kone Cranes, of Finland.

In April of last year executives from APM Terminals, A.P. Moller-Maersk, and ZPMC gathered in Shanghai for a signing ceremony to mark the signing of a Main Purchase Agreement covering ship-to-shore cranes, and other terminal equipment. APM Terminals has already purchased more than 200 cranes from the Shanghai-based manufacturer, and operates a Shanghai office that works in close cooperation in the design and construction of container handling equipment. The office opened in April 2006 and is now staffed by 12 engineers, project managers, and inspectors.
