### Record two million TEUs for APM Terminals Rotterdam

Rotterdam, November 27<sup>th</sup> 2006 - APM Terminals Rotterdam celebrated the handling of the 2,000,000<sup>th</sup> TEU in 2006, surpassing the total number of about 1.75 million TEU handled last year. APM Terminals Rotterdam has experienced an increase of deep-sea volumes this year of more than 30% compared to last year, contributing to this milestone.

This growth in volumes was among other things a result of the integration of the terminals largest customer Maersk Line with P&O Nedlloyd. However, according to APM Terminals Rotterdam director Nick Fisher, it is also a result of a strong growth in the total market. "APM Terminals Rotterdam expects the growth in volumes to continue in 2007. We're happy to ensure our customers that we are prepared for it, continuously focusing on optimizing our terminal", says Fisher.
