What is it?

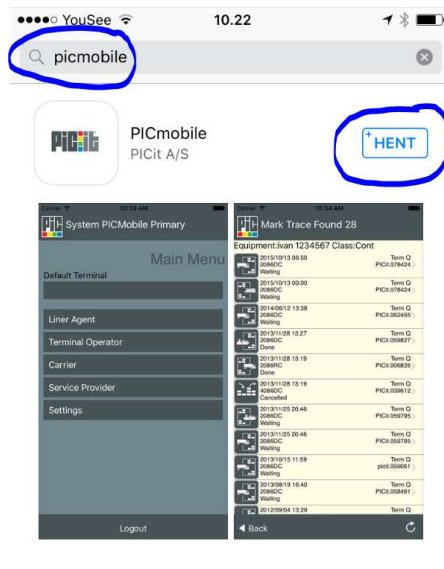
- We have developed in collaboration with PICit an application that allows trucking companies to activate their bookings before they get to the terminal.
- We have tried to make the APP as close as possible to our current self-service kiosk for ease of use.
- The APP has been developed for both Android and IOS.
- This allows truck drivers to drive directly to the gate without any stops prior. They can for example activate their bookings while they are waiting at a customer.
- Remember that the chassis will then need to be locked up at the gate itself while our runner is controlling the container.

- For iPhones and Ipads (IOS), you go to the App Store:

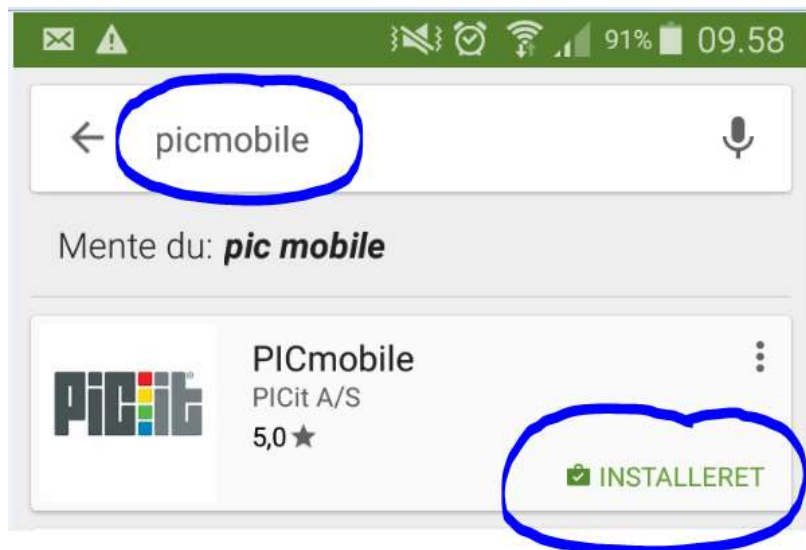


How do I get it?

How do I get it?

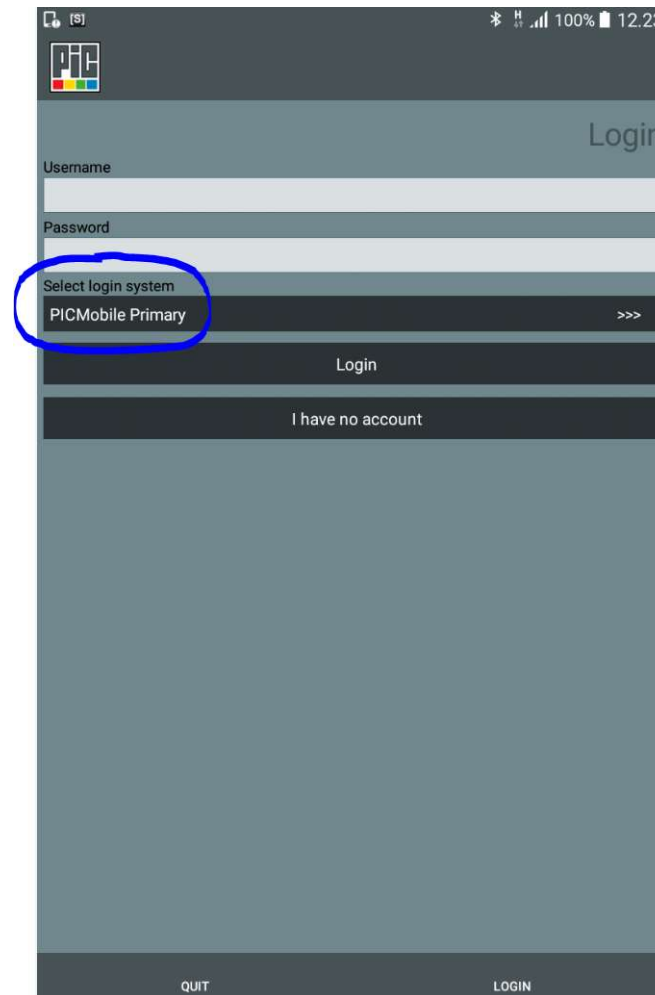


Who can use it?

- EVERYONE driving to APMT Aarhus Terminal.
- Before you use it the first time, you will have to stop at the gate office in order to activate your "driver ID". This is only necessary the first time and takes only one minute to do.
- APMT Aarhus can at anytime cancel a drivers access to the APP if deemed necessary due to abuse, misuse or for security reasons.

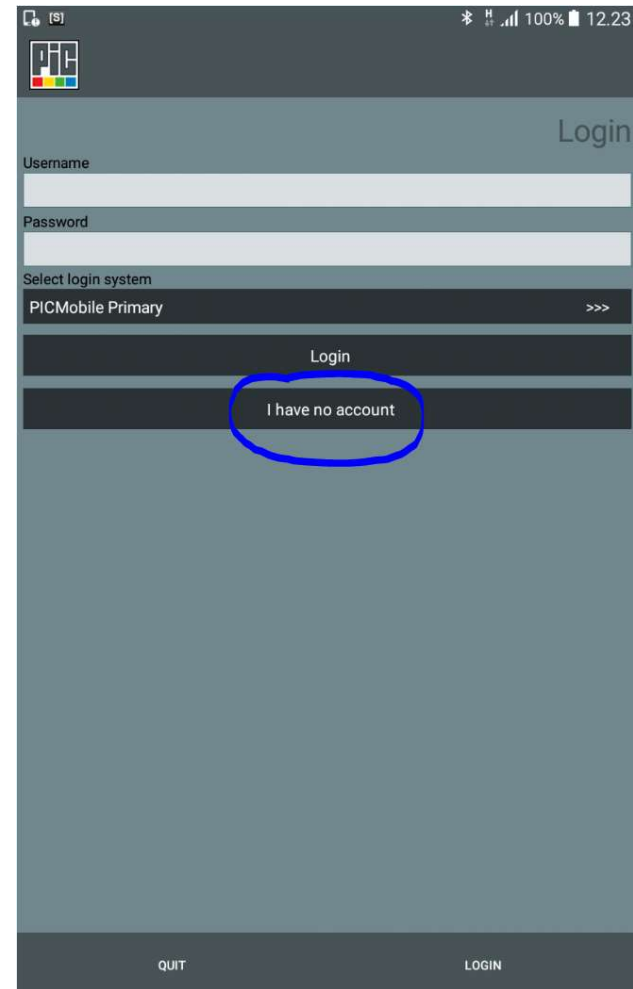

- Make sure you have the right login system. It needs to be "PICMobile Primary". If it is not, select it from the menu.

- You don't need to use any Username or Password. You just then need to select " **I have no account**".



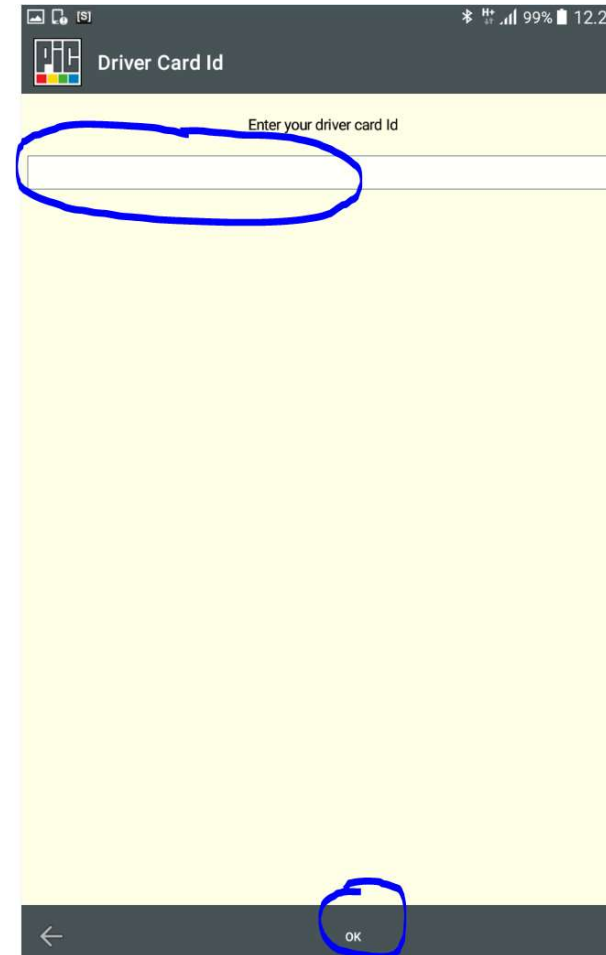

- You then get to a screen where there is only one possibility: "Mobile Self Gate APMT Aarhus Terminal". Select it.



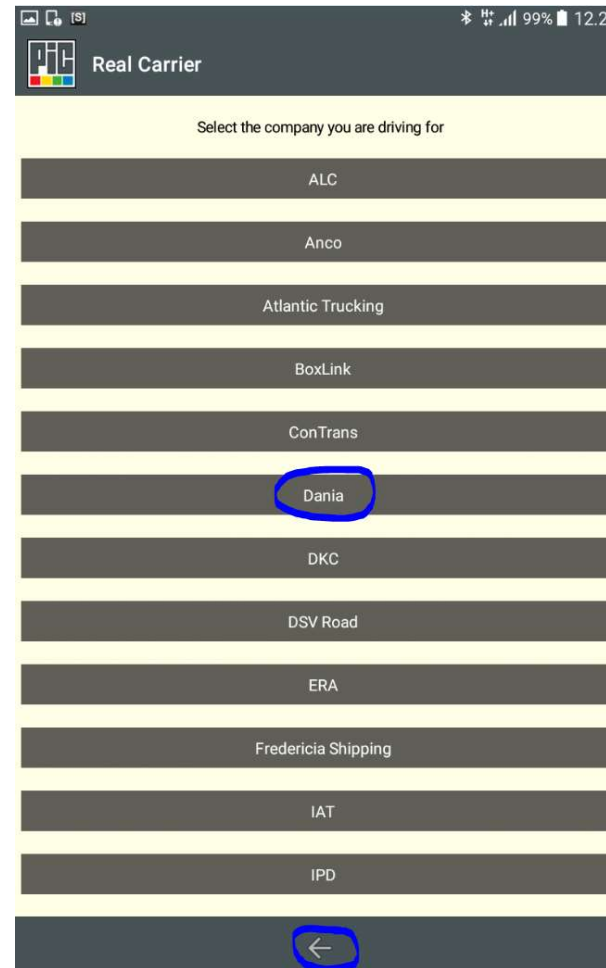
APP's Instructions Manual

- You now need to enter your complete driver card ID. For example: [aaridk1397](#) and then press "OK".
- Android devices will remember your ID for future use.
- For IOS, you can save a shortcut by going to: Settings – General – Keyboard – Text Replacement – "+" and then write your driver ID in the box called "Phrase" and write your desired shortcut in the box called "Shortcut".



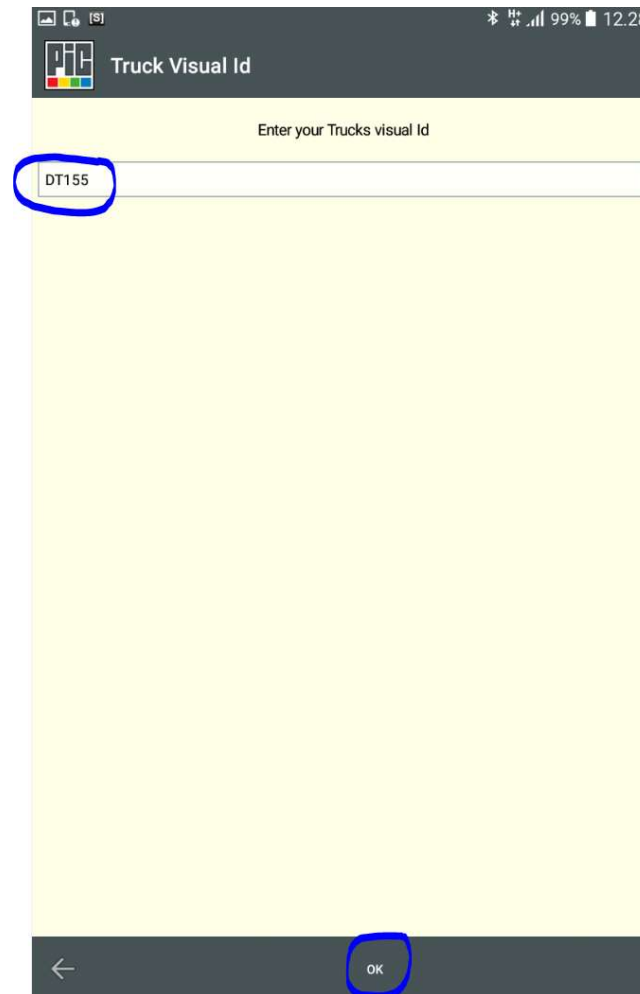

- You then need to select from a list the **company** for which you are driving. This is a scroll down/up menu.
- Take note that there is always an **arrow** at the bottom that allows you to go back to the previous screen. Androids have this arrow while on IOS devices it says "back".

- You then have to write your **trucks visual ID**. It should already be there by default.
- When the right ID is entered you then press "**OK**".

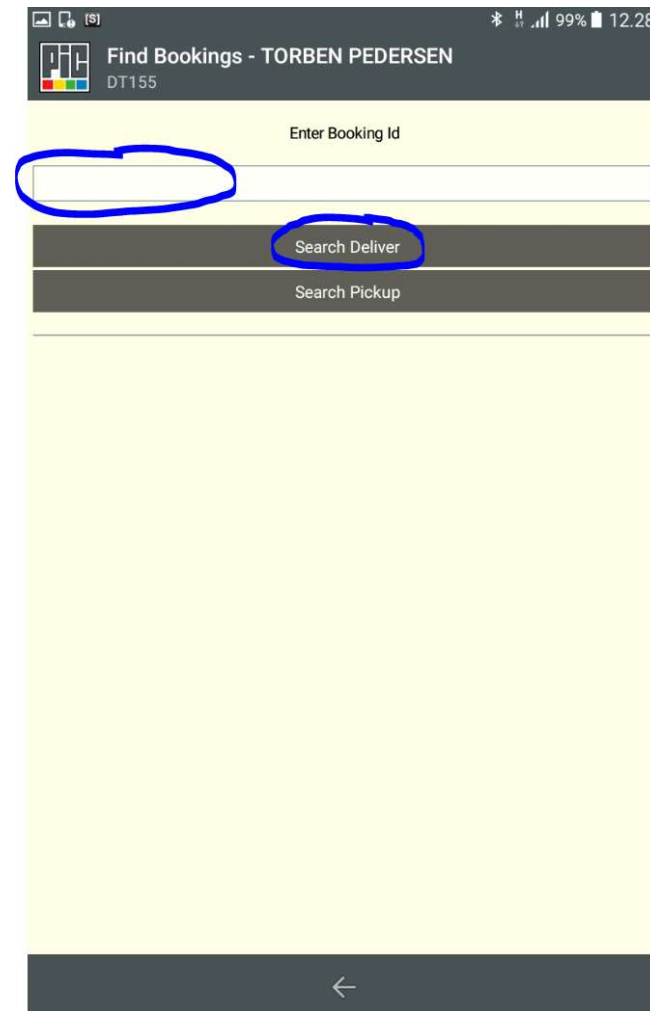

- You then enter your **booking id** in the window.
- Press "**Search Deliver**" if it is a container that you are delivering to the terminal.

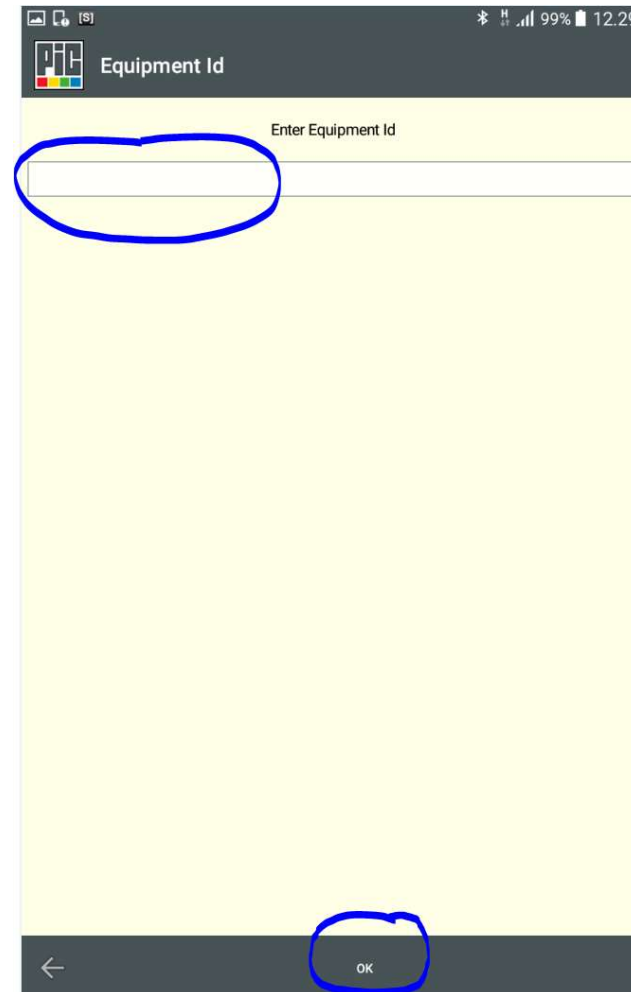
OR

- Press "**Search Pickup**" if it is a container that you are picking up from the terminal.

- You then have to enter the **equipment ID** (container number) in the window.
- When the right equipment ID is entered you then press "**OK**".

- You then have to enter the **seal number** in the window.
- When the right seal number is entered you then press "OK".

- You are then asked if you have more seals for that container.
- Press "Yes" if you do and repeat the process.

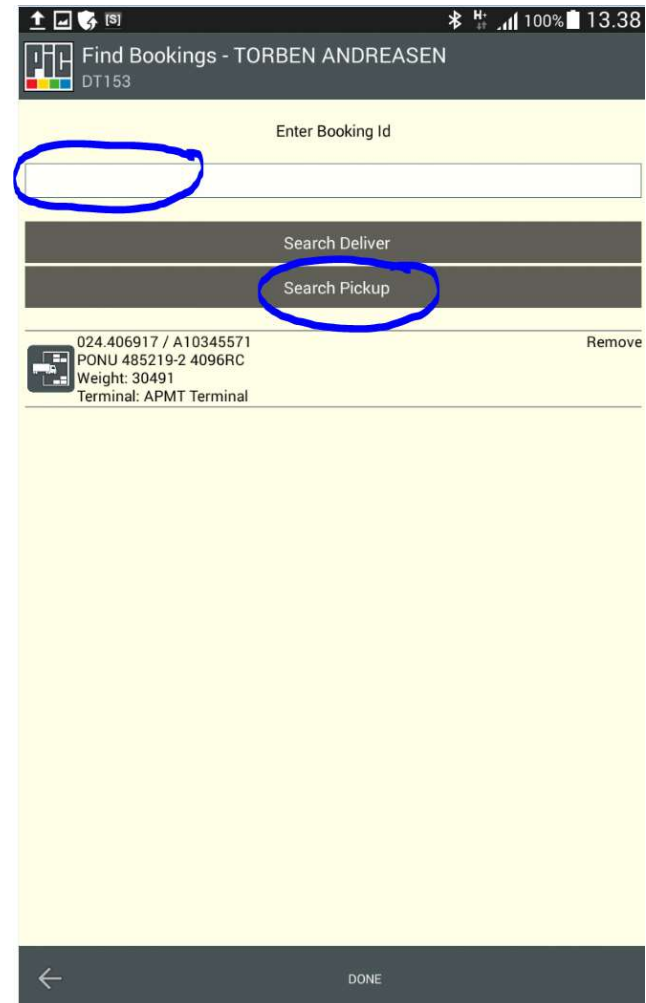
OR

- Press "No" if you don't.



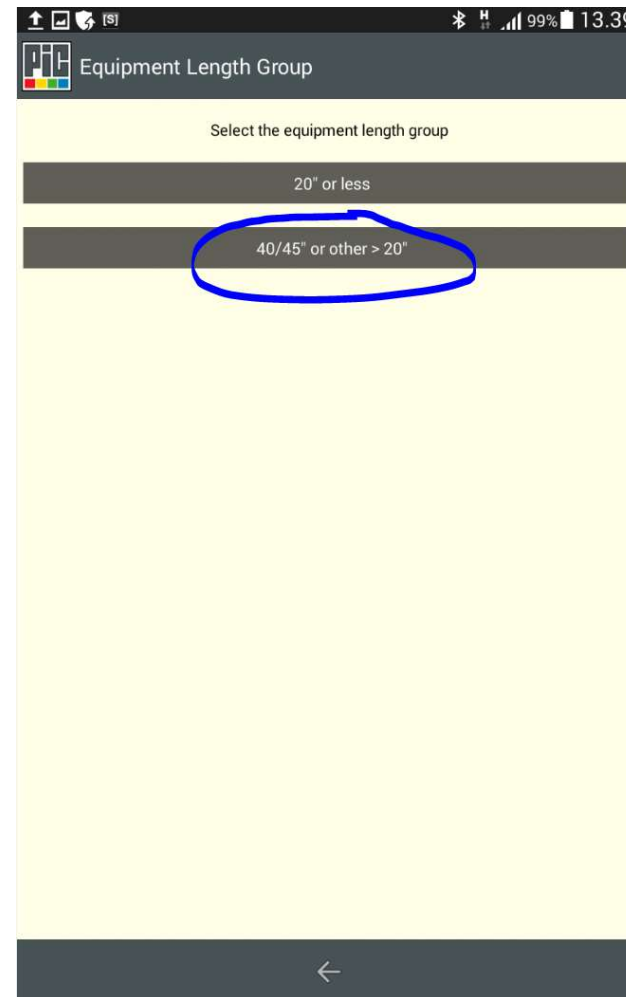

- You can now see a picture of a truck entering the terminal (because this is a delivery) with the most important details.
- You then enter the **booking Id** for the container that you are picking up and press "**Search Pickup**".
- If you DON'T have a pickup you should press "**Done**". We will continue here with the scenario where there is a pickup.



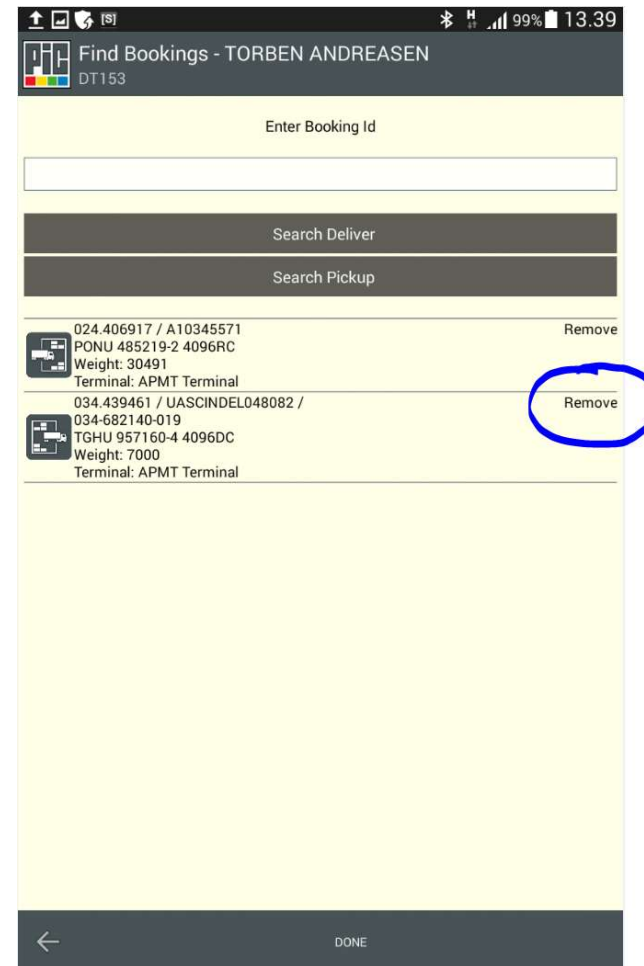

- You then need to select the **size** of the container that you are picking up.

- You can now also see a picture of a truck leaving the terminal with the most important details.
- If you need the remove either a delivery or a pickup you can press "Remove".
- If everything looks fine, you then press "Done".
- The next slide shows you what you get if you press "Remove".

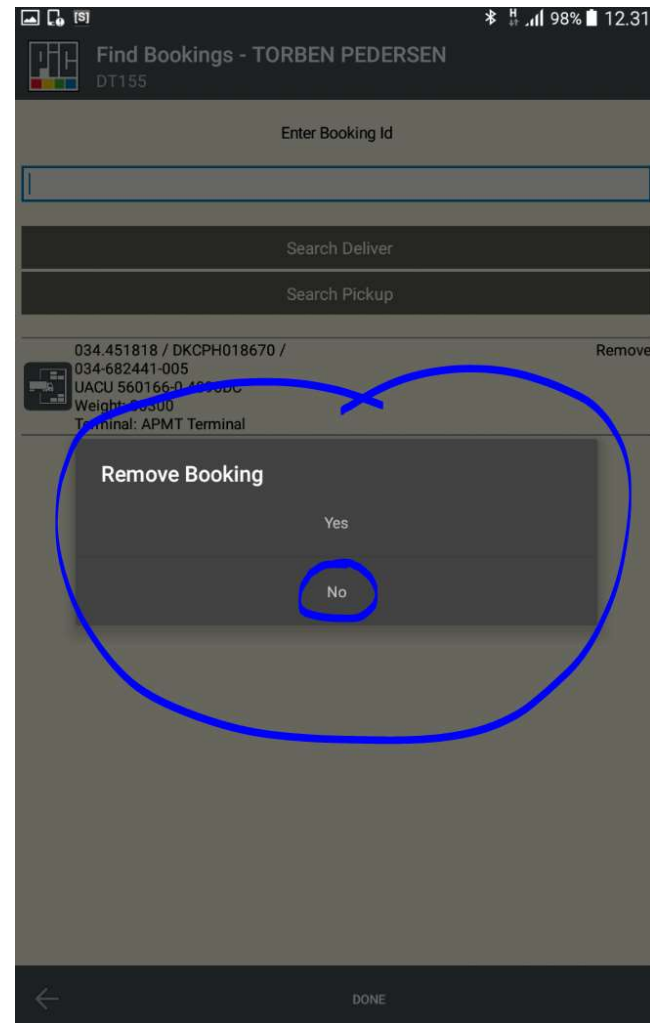

- You can then press "Yes" if you want to remove it.

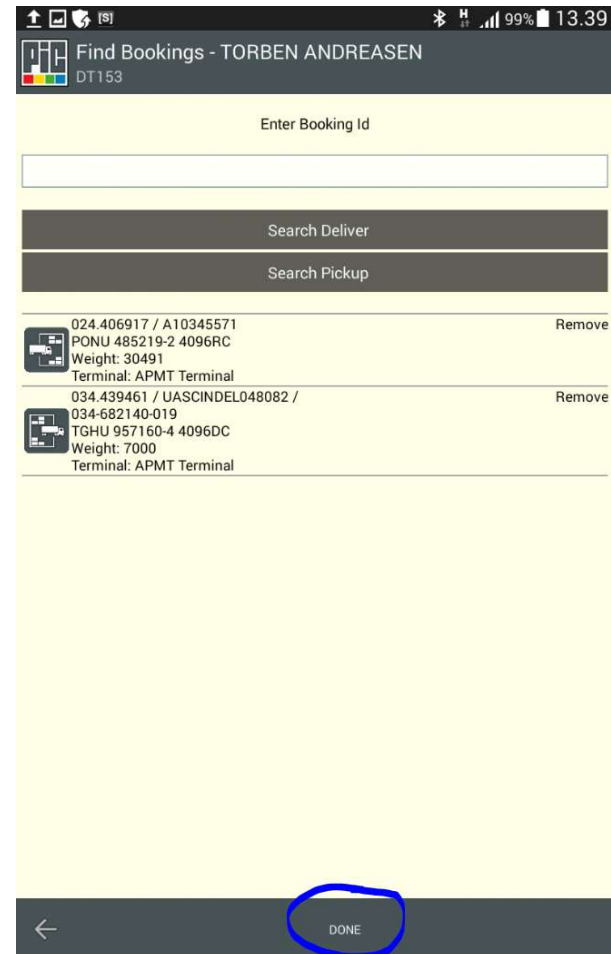
OR

- You can press "No" if you want to keep it.



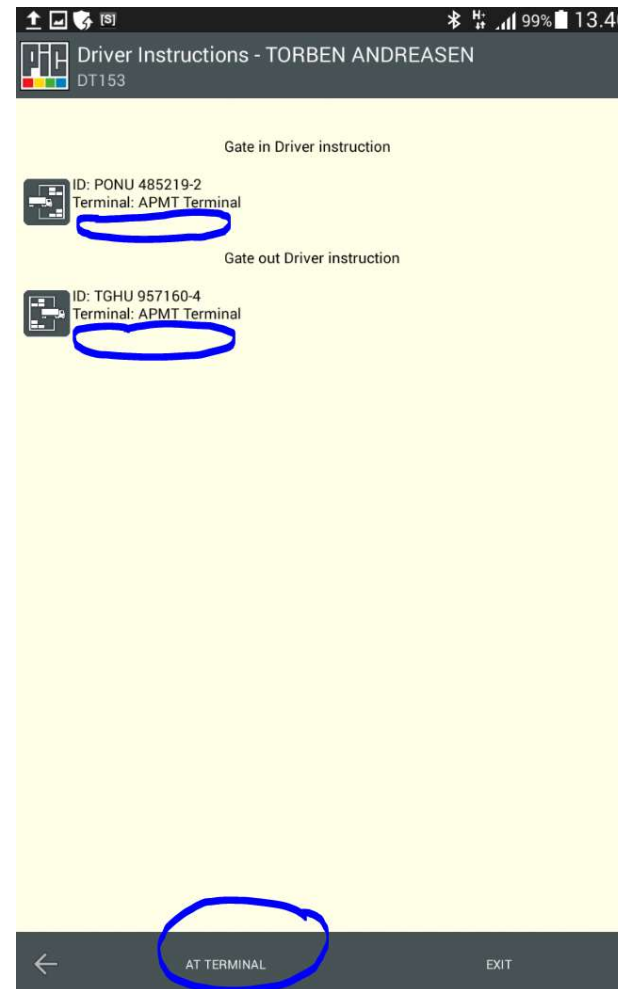

- You then go back to the same screen as before and are ready to press "Done".



APP's Instructions Manual

- You then get to the driver instructions page where the **driver instructions** are actually missing at this stage.
- You need to press **"At Terminal"**, but **ONLY WHEN YOU ACTUALLY ARE AT THE TERMINAL, NOT BEFORE.**
- Until AAD and AAT are merged you will also get a "At Depot" button at the bottom if you do have a container for AAD. This will be removed later.



APP's Instructions Manual

- You can now see, after you have arrived at the terminal and pressed "at terminal", where you should drive to for the different containers.
- You can now "Exit" the APP without erasing anything.
- You will still see the booking(s) if you go back in the APP until you have actually delivered and/or picked up the given container.
