KHALIFA BIN SALMAN PORT*

Khalifa Bin Salman Port (KBSP) is the only commercial port in the Kingdom of Bahrain which is managed and operated by APM Terminals. KBSP is a world class multi-purpose port that handles a diverse range of cargo that includes containers, general cargo such as break-bulk, dry bulk, RO-RO and livestock. The facility also includes a dedicated passenger terminal that is capable of handling cruise and ferry calls. Apart from catering to the local trade in Bahrain, KBSP is ideally positioned to serve as an alternative gateway for the upper gulf, with its ample spare capacity and its customs bonded facility that offers a solution through a sea carriage based option, that allows for storage, if required, followed by prompt customs clearance and onward dispatch by road using the Saudi-Bahrain causeway

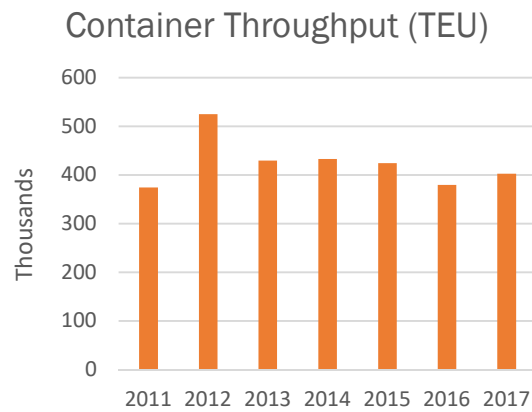
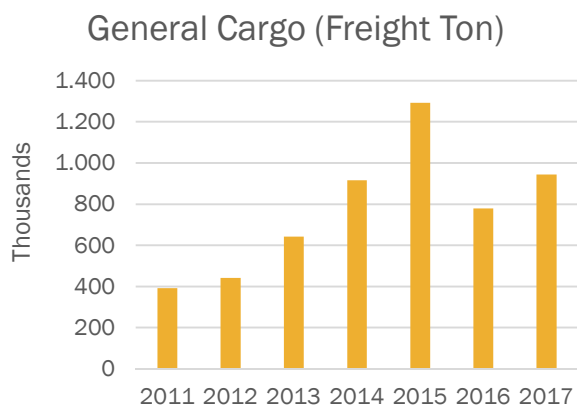

i TEU Stands for Twenty-Foot Equivalent Unit which can be used to measure a ship's cargo carrying capacity. The dimensions of one TEU are equal to that of a standard 20' shipping container. 20 feet long, 8 feet tall

A standard 40' shipping container commonly seen loaded onto a chassis and being pulled by a truck on the highway would thus represent two TEUs, with the largest container ships now able to carry as many as 20,000 TEUs, equal to 10,000 truck-sized containers.
