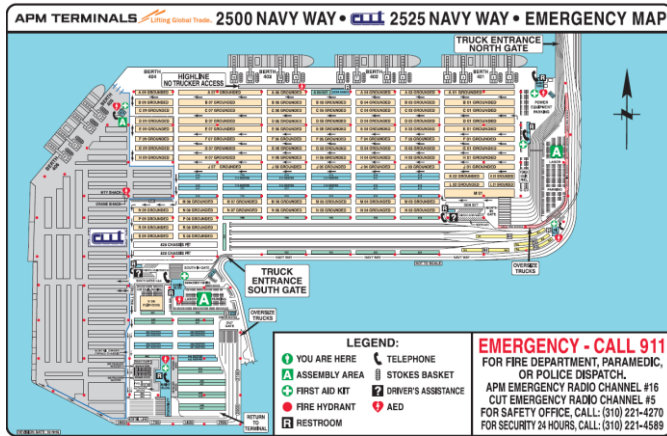


APM Terminals Pier 400 Map and Emergency Evacuation Route



ANY AND ALL services performed on the terminal will be in accordance with 29CFR, Parts 1917, 1918 and 1910 as well as recognized safety work practices to include but not limited to CONFINED SPACE, HOT WORK, LOCKOUT/TAGOUT, ELECTRICAL SAFETY and HAZMAT. **Vendors are responsible for clean up of hazardous spills and all associated cost of emergency response.**

Pier 400 Terminal Rules

- Must check in with security
- Immediately report any incidents or suspicious activity to security
- Drivers STAY in truck cab unless in approved, designated area.
- Speed limit is 15 mph
- No walking on terminal.
- NO DRIVING OR STANDING UNDER THE CRANE
- Yield to all lift equipment. Lift equipment has the right of way.
- Designated fire watch person must be in place for all hot work.
- Children and passengers are not allowed in the terminal.
- No personal vehicles allowed on the terminal.
- Smoking ONLY in designated areas.
- Warn pedestrians in crosswalks of vehicle approach.
- Park in designated areas only.
- Cones or barricades must be erected around all trenches, pits, or work area and be reflective if working at night.
- When parking in a designated area, pull all the way forward into the slot – DO NOT leave vehicle extended into the traffic lane.

Safety, Security and Environmental policies

SAFETY

- Use all Personal Protective Gear (PPE) and other safety devices in a proper manner and at all times where required. This includes visibility vests, hardhats, safety footwear, seatbelts in vehicles and fall protection equipment.



- Observe and follow all warning signs, traffic signs, no smoking signs, speed limits and walkway markings.



- Electronic devices such as cell phones, music devices and earphones are only to be used in break areas



The use of such devices while operating a vehicle is particularly hazardous and is prohibited.

- Riding as a passenger in a vehicle is only permitted if there is a seat provided for that purpose. Use seat belts at all times.

- Immediately report all job-related safety injuries, illnesses or property damage to an APMT representative. **EMERGENCY CONTACT NUMBERS ARE IN THIS DOCUMENT.**
- Immediately report any hazardous conditions or unsafe acts.
- Working under the influence of alcohol or drugs or the consumption or use of them on the company premises is strictly forbidden.



- Fighting, horseplay or distracting behavior will not be tolerated.
- Know emergency signals, evacuation routes and designated assembly areas in the event of an emergency. **AN EVACUATION MAP OF THIS FACILITY IS IN THIS DOCUMENT.**

Environment

- Report all spills or environmental concerns to the terminals designated Environmental Manager. **CONTACT TELEPHONE NUMBERS ARE IN THIS DOCUMENT.**
- Spill kits are available in numerous locations and are clearly marked.
- Vendors must advise HSSE management of hazardous chemicals being brought onto the terminal prior to arrival. All containers must be clearly labeled.
- Vendor or contractor wastes must be disposed of as specified by the terminal.**
- Only qualified and trained personnel and vendors should handle hazardous and/or dangerous materials.

Security

- All persons having access to an APM Terminal MUST have the appropriate APMT/PORT ID as well as a TWIC. The cards must be worn on the outer garment and be visible at all times.
- Guns, knives and other weapons are strictly prohibited.
- The possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs at the terminal is strictly prohibited.
- All vehicles entering and exiting the terminals are subject to search.
- Photography or audio recording is only by permission of the Security Officer.
