#### **Reefer Inspection Chamber**

APM Terminals Pipavav is delighted to inform the development of a Reefer Inspection Chamber which will serve as a dedicated facility for our customers to enable inspection and reworking of cargo in a climate controlled environment and avoid exposure of high value cargo to dust or humidity.



The infrastructure includes a 40 feet air tight Central Refrigerated Compartment with adequate safety controls. The Reefer container under inspection/ reworking can be directly connected to the Compartment on trailer and necessary work can be done. This facility would be made available for customers during this reefer season. This is aligned towards our motto of "CUSTOMER FIRST".

# **Reefer Express lane at port**

We are pleased to announce the commencement of reefer cargoes express lane at our terminal gates from October 2018. This will help faster movement of refer trucks through the port. The customers can fill e form 13 online which will address smoothening of document formalities. The dedicated reefer lane will facilitate faster turnaround for reefer trailers at the port.
