Customer Support Desk at Kathuwas

APM Terminals Pipavav has appointed a Customer support desk at Kathuwas to assist the trade in providing daily support in reporting and coordination of documentation. Our customers will now receive a daily MIS and reports on inward & outward containers, trains to/from Kathuwas/Pali for Pipavav and other destinations. The desk will also help in collection of documents (transference copies for export) for courier and the courier dispatch details will be sent as a daily message to the shipping lines for their reference. The T R copies will be sent directly to the shipping line offices at the port. This will speed up the documentation process and will ensure loading containers on board on time. The help desk will reduce the documentation process to 2-3 days from existing 5-7 days.
